

Meeting & Event Safety Suggestions



Temperature Checks will be conducted before entering the hotel. As additional health measures become available, we will continue to research their implementation. Anyone with an elevated temperature or fever will be asked to seek medical advice before entering the hotel.



Masks are suggested for attendees of your event. If you choose to require masks of your attendees, then our staff will also wear masks in the meeting/event space. Cotton masks, KN95 & N95 masks are all suggested options for your Guests to have available to them when they arrive at the hotel.



In order to reduce contact during your events, we can assist with presetting registration materials on the meeting tables or at place settings keeping your check-in area contact free, or email your attendees their registration materials in advance.



Glove & hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the event. We will have enough disposable gloves for each attendee to wear 3x per day. Touchless hand sanitizer stations will be throughout the meeting space & in common areas. Our staff will use your scheduled break times during the day to resanitize the meeting space & presentation areas prior to the meetings start time & at each break.



Indoor/outdoor spaces will be used as much as possible. We will suggest creative uses of indoor & outdoor areas in order to make attending your reception, education session and other meetings most comfortable for social spacing.



Social Distancing Seating is available for your event. We have created spacing options for your consideration should you wish to increase your event space to accommodate social distance seating. We have modifications with spacing options available for your review and design.



Our new Air Purification System from Global Plasma Solutions (GPS) has industry-leading technology that is proven 99.4% effective to reduce SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) surface strain within 30 minutes. Benefits of this ionization system include purifying indoor air by reducing airborne particulates, odors, and pathogens (bacteria, viruses, mold).

Are you concerned about flying? Research has shown that there is very little risk of any communicable disease being transmitted on board an aircraft. Did you know that the quality of aircraft cabin air is carefully controlled? Ventilation rates provide a total change of air 20-30 times per hour. Most modern aircrafts have recirculation systems, which recycle up to 50% of cabin air. The recirculated air is usually passed through HEPA (high-efficiency particulate air) filters, the type used in hospital operating theatres & intensive care units, which trap dust, particles, bacteria, fungi & viruses.
